

New doctoral regulations of 1 Oktober 2021

Changes for doctoral students who were enrolled into the doctoral candidacy list before 1 October 2021, so that a version of doctoral regulations since 1 January 2014 applies:

1. Preservation of the status quo: Par 29 of the new regulations explain which rules in the new regulations do not apply for those doctoral students because of the preservation of the status quo. Here are the details:

2. All other rules of the new regulations apply for ALL doctoral students, e.g.:

- A certificate of good conduct or work contract is no longer needed to hand in your thesis.
- You submit your dissertation electronically only. Although you need to hand in the original paper documents after uploading them into your docgs account, you don't need to print paper copies any longer.
- A formal consent by your supervisor to hand in a cumulative dissertation is no longer necessary.

3. Change to the new doctoral regulations

If you want to change to the new doctoral regulations please be aware that you will also change to the new TUM-GS statutory regulations. Please consult your GZ before you do so to avoid disagreeable surprises.

4. Cumulative dissertation in MA

The rules for a cumulative dissertation are defined by the department. Therefore there are no changes so far.
